The 2009 Professional Development Conference for Agricultural Educators will be hosted at the Oswegatchie Educational Center. The educational center located in Croghan, New York is nestled on 1200 acres of wooded land within the Adirondack Park. Oswegatchie is owned and operated by the New York FFA Leadership Training Foundation, Inc. The center operates as a youth camp during the summer months and is open throughout the year as an educational, recreational retreat center. We want this conference to be a pleasant and rewarding experience for teachers and their families. Due to the unique nature of this conference several lodging options will be provided to our participants. All facilities are rustic but clean. Sutliff Conference Center

Sutliff conference center has 10 double occupancy rooms. There are two shared shower and bath facilities. In addition there are two dormitories which will sleep up to 24 persons in each.

Widrick Lodge

Widrick has 10 rooms that can accommodate 2 to 4 persons per room. There are two shared bath facilities. Guests may use the shower facility in Sutliff Lodge or one of many shower houses on the property. The main dining room is on the main level of Widrick Lodge.
